

Hearing and Vision Screening

MPA conducts yearly health screenings in the fall. Screenings are mandated by the State of Ohio in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 3313.69. All students entering kindergarten and any students who are new to the school, regardless of grade level, will be screened for vision and hearing. The Children's Hearing and Vision program is a program of early detection, diagnosis and treatment of children with hearing and vision problems. Children who do not pass school hearing and vision screenings will be referred for follow-up care. Please note, parents/guardians will not be notified of screening results unless a referral is necessary. If your child does not pass the vision and/or hearing screening, a referral letter will be sent home with corresponding documentation.

Parents or guardians must inform the school in writing if they do not wish their student to participate in any portion of this program.
